Frederic (Fred) Miclotte has built up an impressive CV as a navigator in a relatively short time. The now 37 year-old Belgian learned the trade in the technically demanding rallies in his country of origin. In classics like the Condroz Rally or the Rally of Ieper, watertight notes and exact timing made the difference between winning and losing.

The talent of the man from Ronse did not go unnoticed. Miclotte debuted on a worldwide level two years after his first rally in the hot-seat next to Bernd Casier during the Rally of Germany in 2005. The following year, he could often be found on international rally roads. Together with Bernd Casier, he took part in five races in the JWRC.

Safari Rally

An absolute classic was on his calendar in 2007: with Italian Luca Betti, Fred Miclotte started the Safari Rally. This was also the year when he first read the notes with Estonian Jaan Molder, with whom the Belgian finished six JWRC races in 2008.

He has been a regular duo with fellow-Belgian Freddy Loix since 2009. This cooperation resulted in three wins in Intercontinental Rally Challenge races last year.

Two world championship points

Together with Dennis Kuipers, the Belgian returned to the world championship in 2010 for a sizeable programme of nine races. With the Dutchman, he matched his best result in the WRC until now: ninth place in the Rally of Turkey. Frederic Miclotte was awarded two world championship points for this excellent achievement.

In the debut year of the new generation of World Rally Cars, the experienced Belgian is starting an even bigger adventure with Dennis Kuipers: 11 world championship races. For this second WRC season with Dennis Kuipers, Frederic Miclotte gave up his day job to concentrate on rallying 100 per cent.
